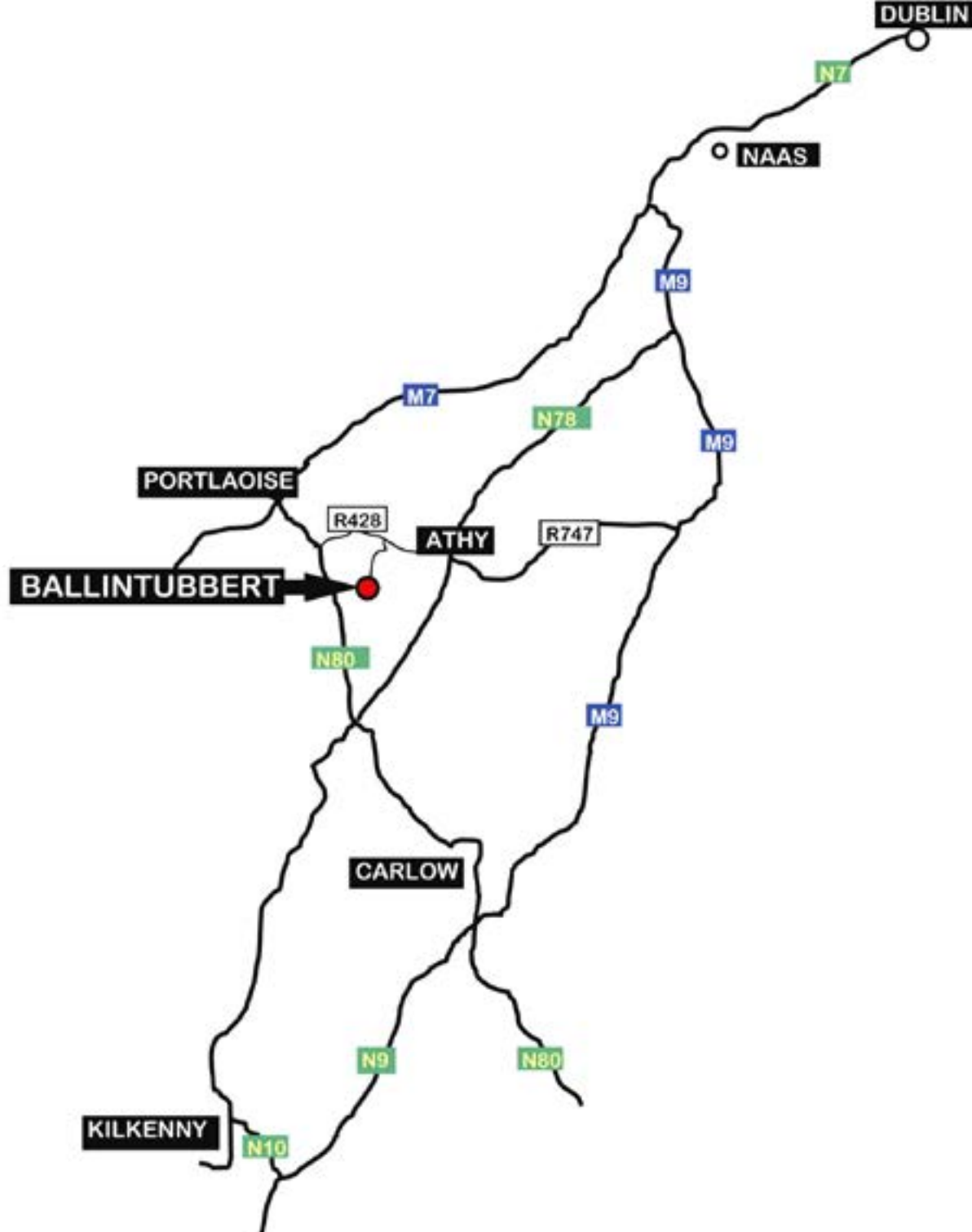


## DIRECTIONS



### BY AIR

The nearest airport is Dublin Airport, less than an hour's drive.

### BY RAIL

The nearest train station is Athy, with trains approximately every two hours - Ballintubbert is a 10 minute taxi ride from Athy station.

### BY ROAD

#### From Dublin:

*Driving time is one hour.*

Take the M7 south to exit 16 Portlaoise.

Follow the N80 signs to the village of Stradbally, passing straight through towards Carlow.

4km beyond Stradbally, look out for the signpost to Ballintubbert on the left hand side.

Turn left as indicated & travel 1.2km - Ballintubbert drive is on the left.

#### From Cork:

*Driving time is 2 hours.*

Take the M8 north to exit 16 Portlaoise then as for Dublin.

#### From Limerick:

*Driving time is 80 minutes.*

Take the M7 to exit 16 Portlaoise then as for Dublin.

#### From Galway:

*Driving time is 2 hours.*

Take N6 to Portumna, then R489 to Birr, N62 to Roscrea, M7 to Portlaoise, then N80 to Stradbally then as for Dublin.

### BY FOOT

Take the Slieve Margy way to Luggacurren. Walk down by the Dun of Cloopuck to Tullamoy, cross the N80, turn left and then right at the sign for Ballintubbert at Hackett's Cross.
